ORDINANCE NO. 1824

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS CITIZENS ADVISORY GROUP

WHEREFORE, In order to promote the general welfare of the community and to assure that the infrastructure in the City shall conform with acceptable community standards; and

WHEREAS the City of Chesterfield has certain standards; and procedures as followed by the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS from time to time it may serve the needs of the City to have an advisory group which can provide technical assistance and advice relative to infrastructure and policy issues as determined by the Department of Public Works;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It is hereby established that the Public Works Citizen Advisory Group, herein after referred to as the Group, exists to provide technical advice and serve in an advisory capacity to the Department of Public Works and the Public Works\Parks Committee of Council.

Section 2. The Public Works Citizen Advisory Group shall consist of twelve (12) members, two from each Ward and four (4) at large members, who shall be appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council.

Section 3. Membership shall consist of four (4) licensed professional civil engineers, four (4) members who shall be Professional Engineers, Architects, contractors, or superintendents of construction and four (4) members who shall be selected and possess relevant professional experience.

Section 4. The members of said Group shall serve for periods of five (5) years.

Section 5. The Group shall select one (1) of its members to serve as Chairperson, and the Department of Public Works shall appoint a Secretary to the Group, who shall keep a detailed record of all proceedings on file with the Group. A copy of the minutes of each meeting shall be transmitted to each member of the Group following the meeting.

Section 6. All meetings of the Group shall be open to the public. The Group shall keep minutes of its proceedings and record the votes of the group..


Section 7. Current membership is to be retained and membership criteria stated in section three (3) shall be achieved through attrition of current membership. All new member appointments shall comply with the aforestated membership qualifications.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
