ORDINANCE NO. 1844

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE BLOCKING OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC ON PUBLIC STREETS – ROADWAYS

Section 1. Blocking of Vehicular Traffic

No person or entity shall block vehicular traffic by placing an obstruction anywhere in a public roadway unless written permission has been granted by the City of Chesterfield. This includes but is not limited to construction materials, organic materials, traffic barricades, and sports/recreation equipment.

Section 2. No person or entity shall block vehicular traffic as a form of protest or civil disobedience.

Section 3. Nothing in this ordinance shall prevent the City of Chesterfield from implementing any traffic or roadway measures deemed necessary, or prevent the City of Chesterfield or other public service agency serving Chesterfield from blocking streets, erecting barricades, or using other means to protect life and/or property, or preserve the peace.

Section 4. Each day that such obstruction shall be in place after notice shall be a separate violation punishable as set out below.

Section 5. Penalties

Any person who violates the provision of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or to imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days, or by both by such fine and imprisonment.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
