ORDINANCE NO. 1853

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF ONE STREET LOCATED IN THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD FROM "THF BOULEVARD" TO "CHESTERFIELD COMMONS DRIVE".

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the City Council that there are two roads named "THF Boulevard" in the general vicinity of one another located in Chesterfield Valley and adjacent to or are contained within what is now the Chesterfield Commons Shopping Center;

WHEREAS, one road named "THF Boulevard" runs east and west and is located south of Chesterfield Airport Road; the other road named "THF Boulevard" runs north and south and is perpendicular and connects with the other similarly named east-west road;

WHEREAS, the addresses for the tenants in Chesterfield Commons Shopping Center are all numbered according to an east-west pattern and refer to the east-west road named "THF Boulevard";

WHEREAS, the City Council determines that it would be convenient, prudent, and in the interest of public safety that the north-south road currently named "THF Boulevard" be renamed "Chesterfield Commons Drive".

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The north-south road currently known as "THF Boulevard" shall be renamed to "Chesterfield Commons Drive".

Section 2. The City Administrator is authorized to take such action as may be necessary to effectuate the name changes with any proper authority and to make all office notifications as appropriate.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
