

BILL NO. 2109ORDINANCE NO. 1883**AN ORDINANCE INTENDED TO CLARIFY AND UPDATE VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE CITY CODE RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Chesterfield, has established as a statutory committee, the Police Personnel Board; and

**WHEREAS**, during the initial incorporation of the City of Chesterfield, the Police Personnel Board was known as the Board of Police Commissioners; and

**WHEREAS**, over time there have been various changes related to the Police Personnel Board, some of which need clarification within the codes and ordinances of the City of Chesterfield;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Article VII: Boards and Commissions, Committees, etc., specifically Section 2-202 relative to the statutory committees is hereby amended by deleting in Section 2-202(2) Board of Police Commissioners and inserting in lieu thereof, the words "Police Personnel Board".

**Section 2.** Section 24-25, which deals with the Annual Report to be submitted by the Board shall be deleted in its entirety and shall be replaced by inserting the following language:

The Board shall submit an annual report to the Mayor and to the City Council. Such report shall be submitted within sixty (60) days after the end of the City's fiscal year.

**Section 3.** Section 24-28 relative to residency requirements shall be deleted in its entirety and shall be replaced and a new section shall be substituted, which shall read as follows:

From and after the passage of this article, all sworn in and commissioned personnel of the department shall be citizens of the United States and live within the State of Missouri during employment with the city police force.

**Section 4.** Code Section 24-32 relative to background investigations and fingerprint check last revised pursuant to Ordinance 534, Section 17 is deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

The Department shall conduct or arrange for background investigations of all applicants. Applicants who have been investigated by other police agencies may be subject to less thorough investigations than other candidates. Each eligible applicant must submit to fingerprinting by the department and be subsequently cleared by a check with the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Missouri State

Highway Patrol, St. Louis County Police Department and the Chesterfield Department of Police immediately prior to certification of appointment.

**Section 5.** Section 24-64 relative to the composition of the Personnel Board being from political parties is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced by a new Section 24-64, which shall read as follows:

Members of the Personnel Board shall not hold any other political office while serving as members of the Board.

**Section 6.** Section 24-76 relative to the Personnel Board shall be deleted in its entirety and a new Section 24-76 shall be inserted, which shall read as follows:


The Police Personnel Board shall be required to meet with the appropriate City officials to discuss issues as determined by the City upon notice by the City Administrator.

**Section 7.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
