ORDINANCE 1888

An Ordinance amending Ordinance Number 1824 establishing Membership Criteria for the Public Works Citizens Advisory Group.

Whereas, In order to promote the general welfare of the community and to assure that the infrastructure in the City shall conform with acceptable community standards; and

Whereas, the City of Chesterfield has certain standards; and procedures as followed by the Department of Public Works; and

Whereas, from time to time it may serve the needs of the City to have an advisory group which can provide technical assistance and advice relative to infrastructure and policy issues as determined by the Department of Public Works; and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Chesterfield passed Bill Number 2048, which became Ordinance Number 1824, which was signed by the Mayor on March 4, 2002, establishing certain criteria for membership on the Public Works Citizens Advisory Group; and

Whereas, it is deemed in the best interests of the City of Chesterfield to further define the criteria for membership on the Public Works Citizen Advisory Group by establishing that the terms of the members of said Group shall be staggered, and, to accomplish such desire by amending Section 3 and Section 4 of Ordinance Number 1824.

Now, therefore, be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chesterfield, St. Louis County, State of Missouri, as follows:

Section 1: Ordinance Number 1824 is hereby amended by deleting Section 3 in its entirety and replacing said Section 3 with the following:

Section 3. Membership shall consist of at least four (4) licensed professional civil engineers, at least four (4) members who shall be either Professional Engineers, Architects, contractors, or superintendents of construction, and up to four (4) members who shall be selected and possess relevant professional experience.

Section 2: Ordinance Number 1824 is hereby amended by deleting Section 4 in its entirety and replacing said Section 4 with the following:

Section 4. The members of said Group shall serve for periods of five (5) years; provided, however, that the initial

terms after the enactment of this Ordinance shall be for terms ranging from one (1) to five (5) years so that no less than two (2) and no more than three (3) terms of the members shall expire in any given year.

Section 3. Except as specifically amended hereby, Ordinance Number 1824 shall be and remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
