ORDINANCE NO. 2088

**AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN HIGHLAND FOREST SUBDIVISION IN THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD**

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield approved the development of the subdivision known as Highland Forest; and

WHEREAS, the streets within said subdivision are part of the residential street system for the subdivision as approved by the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the streets were intended to be public streets and were therefore constructed to the design standards of the Department of Public Works of the City of Chesterfield.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The following streets, part of the residential street system of the subdivision known as Highland Forest, are hereby accepted by the City of Chesterfield for future care and maintenance:

(1) Squires Way Drive: Approximately 680 feet


(2) Highland Forest Court: Approximately 1,000 feet
