ORDINANCE NO. 2193

AN ORDINANCE RE-ADOPTING THE PROCEDURE ESTABLISHED IN ORDINANCE NO. 605 OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD AS THE PROCEDURE FOR DISCLOSURE OF CONFLICTS FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The City of Chesterfield hereby formally re-adopts the procedure set out in Ordinance No. 605 as the procedure for disclosure of potential conflicts of interest and substantial interests.

Section 2. All requirements as set out in Ordinance No. 605 are to remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Missouri Ethics Commission prior to September 15, 2005.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.



This is to remind you that your conflict of interest ordinance expires this year. If you wish to keep this policy in effect, you must readopt it at an open meeting by no later than September 15th and a certified copy (example: signed by presiding officer, board member and attested to by the clerk) mailed to this office within ten days of adoption. If you do not wish to readopt the ordinance, all elected, appointed and decision making personnel will be required to file the personal financial disclosure statement (4 page form) as well as all candidates.
