ORDINANCE NO. 2311

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 35, SCHEDULE IX OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD BY ADDING PROVISIONS THERETO TO RESTRICT PARKING ON JUSTUS POST

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance Number 35, Section 3, Schedule IX as it relates to Parking Restrictions is hereby amended by adding two provisions thereto as follows:

Intersection or location

Parking restrictions

JUSTUS POST, its entire length, extending
From its intersection with Chesterfield Parkway
West southwardly, to its intersection with
Baxter Road.

No Parking, any time

Section 2. In all other respects, Ordinance Number 35 is in full force and effect.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.






