ORDINANCE NO. 2313

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF LYDIA HILL DRIVE ADJACENT TO MONARCH TRACE SUBDIVISION IN THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield approved the development of the subdivision known as Monarch Trace; and

WHEREAS, a portion of Lydia Hill Drive, adjacent to the subdivision, was constructed as part of the street system for the subdivision as approved by the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the street was intended to be a public street and was therefore constructed to the design standards of the Department of Public Works of the City of Chesterfield.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following street, part of the street system constructed with the subdivision known as Monarch Trace, is hereby accepted by the City of Chesterfield for future care and maintenance:


- (1) Lydia Hill Drive: Approximately 845 feet
