AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF DANNA CENTER DRIVE TO LONG ROAD CROSSING DRIVE

WHEREAS, Danna Center Drive in Chesterfield Exchange subdivision is now part of a larger road network that encompasses several properties; and

WHEREAS, it is prudent to identify a contiguous length of road by one name; and

WHEREAS, a consensus has been reached among the property owners involved and the City that the name of the road through all of the developments should be Long Road Crossing Drive;



Section 1. The road designated as Danna Center Drive on the record plat for Chesterfield Exchange subdivision, as recorded in Plat Book 350 Pages 294-295 of the St. Louis County Recorder of Deeds, shall hereby be named Long Road Crossing Drive.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CHESTERFIELD, MISSOURI TO
RENAME DANNA CENTER DRIVE TO LONG ROAD CROSSING DRIVE**

WHEREAS, a named street is proposed to be renamed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it prudent to rename the street listed in this Resolution to serve the citizens of Chesterfield;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The street currently named Danna Center Drive within the City of Chesterfield is to be renamed Long Road Crossing Drive.


Section 2. The City Council hereby declares this change to be necessary and orders that this Resolution be published in a newspaper published within the City of Chesterfield for one week so that resident property owners along the lines of said street may have notice of the proposed change.

Section 3. If a majority of the resident property owners along the lines of said street do not file written protest of the proposed change with the City Clerk within four weeks after the publication of this Resolution, the City Council may then, by ordinance, change the name of the street listed above.

Danna Center Drive to Long Road Crossing Drive


As you are aware, the developers of several properties on the north side of Chesterfield Airport Road west of Long Road cooperated in the development of an overall roadway network, and agreed to names for the streets. A portion of one of those streets was platted prior to any of those discussions. Accordingly, the name of that street, Danna Center Drive in Chesterfield Exchange subdivision, needs to be changed. In accordance with the procedure outlined by the City Attorney per the attached memo of August 14, 2006, the Department of Public Works has prepared the attached resolution and ordinance to rename the street.

Re: Procedure to Name New Streets or to Change Street Names

Due to questions that arose at the last Council meeting concerning the renaming of certain streets, we reviewed this topic and make the following recommendations for the City to follow in renaming streets.

When a developer submits the record plat for a new development, it must include the names and widths of all proposed streets and alleys. §1005.090.8(c) Chesterfield City Code (2006). Additionally, the developer must verify street names and addresses with the United States Postal Service prior to submitting them to the Department. §1005.090.9(c) Chesterfield City Code. When the City approves the Record Plat the new street names are approved.

When it's necessary to change the name of any street or avenue, the City Council shall, by resolution, declare the change necessary, and shall publish the resolution for at least one week in a newspaper in the city. §77.220 R.S.Mo. (2006). If, within four weeks after such publication, a majority of the resident property owners along the line of such street or avenue do not file with the city clerk their written protest against such proposed change of name, then the council shall have power by ordinance to change the name of such street or avenue in accordance with the terms of the resolution. *Id.* When the Ordinance is passed the City Clerk needs to recorder it with the Recorder of Deeds.
