

**AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 18-107 TO CHAPTER 18, ARTICLE IV OF THE CHESTERFIELD CITY CODE RELATING TO THE PARKING OF TRUCKS**

WHEREAS, the parking of commercial motor vehicles with a gross weight in excess of twelve thousand (12,000) pounds in residential districts can interfere with the free and safe flow of vehicular and pedestrian traffic; and

WHEREAS, the parking of commercial motor vehicles with a gross weight in excess of twelve thousand (12,000) pounds in residential districts is unsightly and has a tendency to distract motorists and otherwise pose a hazard to public safety;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, MISSOURI as follows:**

**Section 1.** Section 18-107 of the City of Chesterfield, Missouri, Code is hereby amended, to be designated as Section 18-107, to read as follows:

**Sec. 18-107. Parking of commercial motor vehicles in residential districts prohibited.**

(a) No commercial motor vehicle having a gross weight in excess of twelve thousand (12,000) pounds shall be parked on any roadway or highway in a residential district between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. of any day, except in an emergency.

(b) No tractor or tractor-trailer or tractor-trailer truck unit shall be parked on any roadway in a residential district at any time, except while loading or unloading, with the exception of governmental vehicles during work-in-progress.

(c) No tractor or tractor-trailer or tractor-trailer truck unit shall be parked on any driveway in a residential district at any time, except while loading or unloading.

**Section 2.** The Section assignments designated in this Ordinance may be revised and altered in the process of recodifying or servicing the City's Code of Ordinances upon supplementation of such code if, in discretion of the editor, an alternative designation would be more reasonable. In adjusting such designations, the editor may also change other designations and numerical assignment of code sections to accommodate such changes.

**Section 3.** It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that each and every part, section and subsection of this Ordinance shall be separate and severable from each and every other part, section and subsection hereof and that the City Council intends to adopt each said part, section and subsection separately and independently of any other part, section and subsection. In the event that any part of this Ordinance shall be determined to be or to have been

unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining parts, sections and subsections shall be and remain in full force and effect.


**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
