##### ◆ Garden Project

2. Design- the committee will do most of the design, and will work with the Eagle Scout on materials needed and putting a budget together. Eagle scouts are required to do much of the planning, budgeting, and fund raising for their projects;
3. The committee would work with scouts on setting deadlines and commitments for continued maintenance;
4. Another potential partnering opportunity was brought up- Junior master gardeners. The committee discussed that this might be a better option, as the participants are already displaying interest in plants and gardening;
5. The committee plans on putting together a couple options, then coming up with a possible budget;
6. Tom McCarthy noted that the city is working on the 2013 budget currently, so if the committee wanted this project to be ready for next year they should have a budget request put together as soon as possible;
7. If the committee has other ideas/areas for projects, they should submit plans and budget requests as soon as possible;
8. Kay Folsum volunteered to go to Eberwein and take measurements and start a plan design;
