A. Presenter: Stephen Herring, Republic Services Representative, updates and recommendations for ‘All-in-One’ Recycling Units for Parks Grant opportunity. (15

min.). Reported on the household challenge: 2292 recycled tons in first 6 months of 2015; in first six months of 2016 is 2390 tons; a 15.5 lbs. per household increase in six months. Found several recycle containers we might want to use. Contamination is a prob, especially rain infiltration. Design is a flaw. Cost is a big factor. Operations is also an issue.
