

**MEETING MINUTES**  
**Chesterfield Citizens Committee for the Environment**  
**November 17, 2016, 6:35 p.m.**

**II. Garden Make-Over Gift; YMCA NWF Application was processed and mailed; Upcycling Recycling in Chesterfield Parks Write-up; 2017 Earth Day Tree Order List corrected; 10/11/16 NWF Call Notes were sent in late but are there now; International Earth Hour Flyer 2016; *Conservation Federation*, 11/2016, “Invasive Honeysuckle, Wildlife and You,” “Horses Still Roam Free Along Scenic Riverways,” and “Missouri Group Hires Monarch and Pollinator Coordinator;” *Missouri Conservationist*, 11/16, “Forests and Woodlands...a treasure chest...,” “2016-2017 Seedling Order Form” (go on-line to view at MDOC); *Resource Recycling*, 11/16, “Bag Ban Basics.”

**III. “Sustainability by Design” Projects.**

- A. Presenter: Mary Patterson, St. Louis County Dept. of Public Health – Waste Diversion Supervisor; provided updates on household waste, our 2017 Grant cycle/opportunity and other topics. Patterson reported that no personnel/staff costs prior to grant award would be funded. No costs incurred prior to grant approval will be approved. Our baseline measurement element in the grant proposal is good. The two field studies impressed Ms. Patterson and she indicated they would help guide recycling efforts in the County. New recycle containers *must* have the recycle (reduce, reuse, recycle) logo and SLCDOH identifier on each. Grants will be due on March 1<sup>st</sup>. If we keep costs under \$25,000, the proposal will not have to go to the County Council for approval, which would add six weeks to the process. In-kind services: City staff time, Republic staff time, or CCE member time would qualify; City provision of waste bags can count and city staff practice in changing bags can also count; graphic design costs would count; all grants over \$10,000

must have an in-kind match. \$20.00 may be available for CCE in-kind service (Mary needs to research that number) per hour labor costs. She advised us to use the word “Landfill” instead of “Trash” on containers, for which we will need labels too. Reducing landfill waste should be our main goal. We’re following a MORRA guideline of “Strive for 75%” diversion rate. Household hazardous waste program had looked at a Spirit of St. Louis site. The West County site is not on top of their list as that type of waste constitutes too small a part of the total waste stream.
