
REPORT OF THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR

Mr. Herring noted that the purpose of the meeting was to approve issuance of a liquor license renewal to Oscar's Restaurant, located at 1765 Clarkson Road, to sell all kinds of intoxicating liquor by the drink to be consumed on the premise and Sunday Sales. Fee for this license is \$700.00. The current liquor license had expired at midnight on July 1, 1994, and this establishment has been prohibited from serving alcoholic beverages since then. A renewal application was submitted after this date and reviewed and approved by Chief of Police Ray Johnson and Director of Planning Jerry Duepner.

With this in mind, a motion was made by Councilmember Levinson, seconded by Councilmember Tilley, to approve issuance of the liquor license. A voice vote was taken with a unanimous affirmative result and the motion was declared passed.


ADJOURNMENT
