MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD
AT 922 ROOSEVELT PARKWAY
SEPTEMBER 18, 1995

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Boy Scout Troop #848 from Highcroft Ridge School: Alex Smith, Chad Gray, Jay Huetteman, Hal Rutherford, Michael Staz and Michael Schwartz. Also in attendance was Troop Leader Thomas Smyka.

The Reverend Joseph Pins from Ascension Catholic Church led the City Council in prayer.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the September 5, 1995, City Council meeting were submitted for approval. A motion was made by Councilmember Cullen, seconded by Councilmember Tilley, to approve the minutes. A voice vote was taken with an affirmative result (Councilmember Flachsbart "Abstained") and the motion was declared passed.

INTRODUCTORY REMARKS

Mayor Jack Leonard presented former Chairperson of the Planning Commission Barbara McGuinness with a Proclamation and bouquet of flowers in recognition of her dedication and service to the City of Chesterfield, since incorporation June 1, 1988.

Mayor Leonard placed the names of the following individuals in nomination to serve as members of the Chesterfield Arts Commission: Don Wiegand, Faith Martens, Beth Gorman, Bud Hirsch, Jade Bute, Kathy Higgins, Tom McCarthy, George Goodman, Laurie McTearden. He stated that these individuals had been selected for their expertise in this area. A motion was made by Councilmember Politte, seconded by Councilmember Hurt, to approve the nominations for the Chesterfield Arts Commission. A voice vote was taken with a unanimous affirmative result and the motion was declared passed.

Mayor Leonard next placed the name of Mary Domahidy in nomination as a member of the Finance and Administration Citizens Advisory Committee to fill the unexpired term of Charles Kim. A motion was made by Councilmember Cullen, seconded by Councilmember Tilley, to approve Ms. Domahidy's appointment. A voice vote was taken with a unanimous affirmative result and the motion was declared passed. Ms. Domahidy's term will expire June 15, 1996.

COMMUNICATIONS AND PETITIONS

Mr. Peter Elsaesser, who resides at 1144 Deep Forest Drive, expressed his concern regarding Windridge Estates as it relates to accessibility of the road during construction and drainage problems.

Mr. Murray Fishman, who resides at 1122 Deep Forest Drive, expressed his concern regarding stormwater drainage associated with Windridge Estates.

Ms. Elizabeth Elsaesser, who resides at 1144 Deep Forest Drive, expressed her concern regarding road accessibility and drainage problems related to Windridge Estates.

Ms. Micaela Kennedy, who resides at 1122 Deep Forest Drive, expressed her concern that the residents concerns regarding Windridge Estates were not being addressed.

COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS

Public Health and Safety

Councilmember Colleen Hilbert, Chairperson of the Public Health and Safety Committee, reported that the Committee recommends that City Council support the efforts of the Department of Conservation with regard to control of deer herds within the community. A motion was made by Councilmember Hilbert, seconded by Councilmember Streeter, to support the efforts of the Department of Conservation with regard to control of deer herds

within the Chesterfield community. A voice vote was taken with a unanimous affirmative result and the motion was declared passed.

Councilmember Hilbert next reported that Bill #'s 1138, 1139 will be read for the first time and Bill #'s 973, 1118 - 1120 will be considered for adoption under the Legislation portion of the agenda.

Councilmember Hilbert announced that the next meeting of this Committee has been scheduled for October 9, 1995, at 6:30 P.M.

Planning and Zoning

Due to the absence of Councilmember Ed Levinson, Chairperson of the Planning and Zoning Committee, Councilmember Dan Hurt, member of the Committee, gave the report. Councilmember Hurt reported that Bill #'s 1141 - 1143 and Bill #'s 1127 - 1129 will be considered for adoption under the Legislation portion of the agenda. Some discussion ensued with regard to Bill #1129 pertaining to road accessibility.

Councilmember Hurt announced that the next meeting of this Committee has been scheduled for September 21, 1995, at 5:30 P.M.

Public Works/Parks

Councilmember Alan Politte, Chairperson of the Public Works/Parks Committee, reported that Bill #1137 will be considered for adoption under the Legislation portion of the agenda.

Councilmember Politte announced that the next meeting of this Committee has been scheduled for September 20, 1995, at 7:30 P.M.

Finance and Administration

Councilmember Linda Tilley, Chairperson of the Finance and Administration Committee, reported that Bill #1140 will be read for the first time and Bill #1133 will be considered for adoption under the Legislation portion of the agenda.

Councilmember Tilley next reported that Resolution #191 would approve a six-month contract extension between the City of Chesterfield and the Chesterfield Community Development Corporation for the services of Mr. Lee McKinney. A motion was made by Councilmember Tilley, seconded by Councilmember Streeter, to approve a six-month contract extension between the City of Chesterfield and the CCDC for the services of Mr. Lee McKinney. A voice vote was taken with a unanimous affirmative result and the motion was declared passed.

Councilmember Tilley next reported that the Committee recommends City Council approve a one-year extension of severance agreement for the CCDC Administrator. It was noted that the original agreement has been fulfilled and it was suggested that CCDC consider other alternatives for the Administrator. A motion was made by Councilmember Hurt, seconded by Councilmember Tilley, to approve the one-year extension severance agreement for the CCDC Administrator. A voice vote was taken with an affirmative result (Councilmember Flachsbart voted "No") and the motion was declared passed.

Councilmember Tilley announced that the next meeting of this Committee has been scheduled for October 5, 1995, at 7:30 P.M. or October 11, 1995, at 5:30 P.M.

REPORT OF THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR

Due to the absence of City Administrator Mike Herring, Assistant City Administrator/Personnel Director Brenda Love Collins stated that Director of Public Works/City Engineer Mike Geisel has recommended that the bid submitted by MHCC, Inc. be approved by City Council, to cover a specific project to place sidewalks adjacent to Justus Post Drive, as well as 869 additional feet of sidewalk replacements to be performed throughout the City. The replacements range in length from 5 ft. to 214 ft. All of this work will be accomplished within the budgeted dollars available of \$61,800. A motion was made by Councilmember Politte, seconded by Councilmember Flachsbart, to approve the bid submitted by MHCC, Inc. A voice vote was taken with a unanimous affirmative result and the motion was declared passed.

Brenda Collins next reported that Director of Public Works/City Engineer Mike Geisel has recommended that the bid submitted by Chesterfield Signs, totaling \$29,175, be approved by City Council. Approval of this bid will enable acquisition of sixteen (16) signs and installation of eleven (11) signs at various entrances into the City of Chesterfield. The design for the signs has previously been approved by the Public Works/Parks Committee and City Council. A transfer of \$9,175 from the Subdivision Beautification Program account will be necessary in order to accommodate this total bid, since an allocation of \$10,000 was contained within the current budget for this purpose. A motion was made by Councilmember Politte, seconded by Councilmember Cullen, to approve the bid submitted by Chesterfield Signs, totaling \$29,175. A voice vote was taken with a unanimous affirmative result and the motion was declared passed. A motion was then made by Councilmember Politte, seconded by Councilmember Cullen, to transfer \$9,175 from the Subdivision Beautification Program account in order to accommodate this total bid. A voice vote was taken with a unanimous affirmative result and the motion was declared passed.

Ms. Collins next reported that a liquor license request has been received from Paul Manno's Cafe, located at 75 Forum Center. The restaurant is requesting to sell all kinds of intoxicating liquor by the drink to be consumed on the premise, fee \$450.00. The application has been reviewed and approved by Chief of Police Ray Johnson and Director of Planning Jerry Duepner. A motion was made by Councilmember Tilley, seconded by Councilmember Streeter, to approve issuance of the liquor license. A voice vote was taken with a unanimous

affirmative result and the motion was declared passed.

NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Mike Geisel, Director of Public Works/City Engineer, reported that a meeting of the Monarch-Chesterfield Levee District has been scheduled for September 19, 1995, at 3:00 P.M. The Levee District contacted the City to request the City's proxy for votes in favor their proposed tax question which they will be submitting to all residents of the taxing districts. Discussion took place. A motion was made by Councilmember Cullen, seconded by Councilmember Hurt, to approve the City's proxy for votes in favor of the Levee District's proposed tax question to be submitted to all residents of the taxing districts. A roll call vote was taken with the following results: Ayes - Hilbert, Streeter, Hurt, Politte, Cullen, Tilley. Nays - Flachsbart. The motion was declared passed.

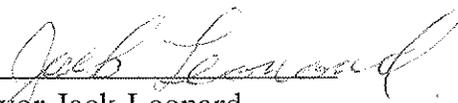

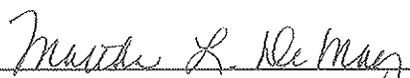
ADJOURNMENT
