# Planning/Public Works Committee

Bill No. 3253

Amends the Unified Development Code of the City of Chesterfield by changing the boundaries of the "NU" Non-Urban District to a "PC" Planned Commercial District for a 3.1 acre tract of land located on the north side of Olive Street Road west of its intersection with Premium Way. [P.Z. 09-2018 18633 Olive Street Rd (Herman

& Connie Grimes) 17W530101] (Second Reading) Planning Commission recommends approval. Planning & Public Works Committee recommends approval, as amended

Councilmember Mary Ann Mastorakos, Chairperson of the Planning/Public Works Committee, made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Ohley, for the second reading of Bill No. 3253. A voice vote was taken with a unanimous affirmative result and the motion was declared passed. Bill No. 3253 was read for the second time. A roll call vote was taken for the passage and approval of Bill No. 3253 with the following results: Ayes – Ohley, Keathley, Mastorakos, DeCampi, Hurt, Monachella, Moore and McGuinness. Nays – None. Whereupon Mayor Nation declared Bill No. 3253 approved, passed it and it became **ORDINANCE NO. 3062.** 

Bill No. 3257

Amends the Unified Development Code of the City of Chesterfield by changing the boundaries of the "NU" Non-Urban District to an "E-1/2AC" Estate Half Acre District for a 4.76 acre tract of land located on the south side of Old Clarkson Road approximately 900 feet from its intersection with Baxter Road [P.Z. 11-2018 15750 Old Clarkson Rd, Kumara S. Vadivelu (NU To E-1/2AC) 19S130015] (First Reading) Planning Commission recommends approval. Planning & Public Works Committee recommends approval

Councilmember Mastorakos made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Ohley, for the first reading of Bill No. 3257. A voice vote was taken with a unanimous affirmative result and the motion was declared passed. Bill No. 3257 was read for the first time.

Bill No. 3258

Provides for the approval of a Boundary Adjustment Plat for the consolidation of three parcels totaling 10.15 acres, with all parcels zoned "NU" Non-Urban District (18W310289, 18W310267, 18W310366) (First & Second Readings) Department of Planning & Development Services recommends approval

Councilmember Ohley made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Monachella, for the first reading of Bill No. 3258. A voice vote was taken with a unanimous affirmative result and the motion was declared passed. Bill No. 3258 was read for the first time.

Bill No. 3259

Provides for the approval of a Boundary Adjustment Plat for Lots 55 and 56 of Old Clarkson Forest Subdivision to create a 0.55 acre tract of land and a 0.55 acre tract of land, zoned "R1A" Residence District (20S430104, 20S430113) (First & Second Readings)

Department of Planning & Development Services recommends approval

Councilmember Moore made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Ohley, for the first reading of Bill No. 3259. A voice vote was taken with a unanimous affirmative result and the motion was declared passed. Bill No. 3259 was read for the first time.

Councilmember Ohley made a motion, seconded by Councilmember McGuinness, for the second reading of Bill No. 3259. A voice vote was taken with a unanimous affirmative result and the motion was declared passed. Bill No. 3259 was read for the second time. A roll call vote was taken for the passage and approval of Bill No. 3259 with the following results: Ayes – DeCampi, Ohley, McGuinness, Moore, Hurt, Monachella, Mastorakos and Keathley. Nays – None. Whereupon Mayor Nation declared Bill No. 3259 approved, passed it and it became **ORDINANCE NO. 3064.**
