

CHESTERFIELD HISTORIC AND LANDMARKS PRESERVATION COMMITTEE
MINUTES FOR WEDNESDAY, MAY 10, 2017 5:30

Meeting called to order by Tom Rothwell at 5:30.
Justin introduced the new zoning aide at City Hall, Cassie Harashe.

Minutes from the March 8, 2017 meeting were approved after several corrections.

Treasurer's Report by DeeAnn: As of March 31, 2017 the CHLPC fund was \$26,897.95. A breakdown of total sales for books and calendars and from calendar sponsors was included. As of April 30, 2017, the balance was \$27,001.47.

Sean Sortor will be donating ancient Chesterfield artifacts to the City Council. Steve will help identify the objects.

Lynne gave a brief report on both the progress on the World War Two display in the City Hall corridor and the very successful and well-attended inauguration of the Chesterfield Veterans Honor Park in Central Park. Several local World War Two veterans, active duty representatives from each service and American Legion members were in attendance even with the downpour.

DeeAnn presented the offer of a store area in Chesterfield Mall for use by the CHLPC for exhibits. Our group would pay utilities and a nominal rent per month. Jane asked about insurance. We would not have to meet normal store 'open hour' periods. Justin will speak with the City Council about the possible offer.

Additional cemetery pictures presented by George will be posted by Justin on the City Web Site.

The Bonhomme School bell is now on display in the Rockwood School District offices in Eureka.

Jane Durrell presented examples of the Wildwood Historic Calendars and we discussed and then approved the following for the CHLPC 2018 calendar:

Calendars will be printed in black on white stock,
we will have several more pages of advertising but will give away the calendars in stores, nursing homes, and locations of sponsors,
we will ask for some paid design help,
we will seek competitive bids from printers.

Jane brought up the idea of a CHLPC scholarship for local students. We will ask Justin how that would work. Lynne suggested that students submit original interviews on the history of Chesterfield neighborhoods.

Jane brought up a recent zoning hearing on a proposed apartment complex on Old Chesterfield Road. This complex would abut the Historic District of Old Chesterfield Road. We will find out if it is appropriate for the CHLPC to submit a letter of opposition to the project due to the proximity of the Historic District.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:00.
