2. Barb asked for proposals for the future direction of CHC. The following proposals were discussed.
  - a) Barb suggested giving an award to students for historical projects. Bob and Doris DeFer will develop a theme for an essay contest.
  - b) Aimee reported that Chesterfield needs a not for profit partner to preserve the Eberwein house. The cost analysis indicated that

\$400,00-\$600,000 would be needed for a complete exterior and interior rehab.

- c) Jane proposed that CHC create a restoration subcommittee.
- d) Jane proposed that CHC develop a self-guided audio tour with an annotated map to explore historical sites in Chesterfield. This proposal would need help from people beyond CHC members.
