MINUTES FOR SEPTEMBER 11, 2019

Jane Durrell, Chairman, brought the meeting to order at 5:30 and introduced the guest Jack Avery.

Jane announced that there will be Recycle Day held between Sears and Macy's around November 2.

A motion was made by Ann Chrissos and seconded by DeeAnn Wright to approve the July 10 minutes. The motion passed.

Treasurers Report: DeeAnn announced that the balance as of June 30, 2019 was \$19,249.40. Income between June 30 and August 30 was \$754. Expenses were \$700. The balance as of August 31, 2019 was \$19,303.40.

All of the 2019 Calendar ads have been paid for. Extra 2019 calendars will be given out at the museum. Old calendars will be put out for display.

The Museum is ready for the September 26 Archeology Event and book signing by Mark Leach at the Museum from 6:30 to 9:00.

Anne Lewis gave the 2020 Calendar report. The printing cost has increased by 12%. Anne gave the price options for three various print quantities.

A motion was made by Lynne Johnson seconded by Mike Kane to order 3,500 copies printed. The motion was passed. There will be more ad income for the 2020 calendar than the 2019.

During the November meeting we will look at examples of a black and white calendar as opposed to color.

Library Display: Mark Leach will do the October display using archeology. Anne, Ann and Lynne will do the December display with old Christmas cards.

The Faust Park festival will be held September 28 & 29. The CHLPC booth will be inside Thornhill. Most of the volunteer time slots were filled except Sunday morning.

Ann and George will represent CHLPC at the St. Louis County Library Headquarters on October 26 from 10 to 1. They might need the CHLPC tablecloth from the museum.

DeeAnn gave the report on the Museum. A large identifying sign has been erected over the museum entrance. DeeAnn hopes that two smaller signs with arrows will be added to aid in finding the museum location. More museum visitors come on a Saturday than Friday. Groups that sign up in advance make up most attendance.

This years Vintage Days will be held inside the old Sears store on October 26. The CHLPC may request a table.

Mike Kane hopes that the City Council could be more involved in the CHLPC by appointing interested citizens to the committee. We should all ask our council members to find candidates. We should also ask groups to visit the museum.

George Chrissos mentioned that more Trivia pamphlets should be at City Hall.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:40.

The next meeting will be November 13 when we will hold elections.
