Archeology - Stan has checked the areas of the proposed Chesterfield outlet malls and has not found artifacts.

An announcement of a lecture on the Chesterfield Dampier Archeological Site (Discovered by Stan Dampier) has been submitted to the West News Magazine. The presentation will be at the Sachs library from 7 to 8 PM on Wednesday, September 26.

Archives - **Twenty-seven boxes were inventoried. Some items need to be disposed of.** Tom suggested a “Throwaway Box” that the CHLPC members could look through to salvage any important artifacts which should be saved. Bill introduced a box labeling system. The system will have several stages of sorting. Stan suggested that items be sorted by site.

Oral history - No meetings this summer.

Publications – 2013 calendar printed. Arland Stemme stepping down from calendar committee after 22 years . Each 2013 calendar will sell for \$2. Six hundred have been printed costing a total of \$2,501.

We are very concerned with helping Don save his slaughter house which is a Chesterfield Landmark. Information about the Spirit of Hope Award designed by Don and the Weigand Foundation was shared.

Photo ID - Rena Rothwell presented photos of historic houses taken by Dan in past years. No identification of photos yet.

Finance - Discussed how the committee can encourage more sales of the historical publications. Amiee will add our publication list to Chesterfield City web site. Discussed approaching local school PTO about distribution of CHLPC books. Tania and Rena will take 2012 calendars to local schools to give to libraries and students.

Archeology Award - Discussed encouraging CHLPC members to be present at next year’s award ceremony.

Faust Park - **One old barn and one old store will be arriving at Faust Park if money is found to move them.** Faust Park is requesting funds. Motion made to make donation to Faust Park. Decision made to ask for staff to investigate specifics for a vote during our November meeting.

Lynne requested that the CHLPC members make suggestions about new projects and ideas such as: Looking for Civil War connections in Chesterfield or involving middle school children in researching history of Chesterfield subdivisions or service groups. Why did people immigrate to Chesterfield in different time periods?

Discussed making master list of Chesterfield schools.

Discussed looking for places to display old Chesterfield artifacts and oral interviews. The need to accumulate old oral histories.

Discussed re-tooling subcommittees to increase efficiency and interest.

Discussed making future CHLPC plans that will still be meaningful years from now.

Discussed scheduling meetings in 2013; changing time and/or dates. The need to have more relevant agendas.

Should Eberwein Farm Barn be included on Historic Register ? Unanimous vote Yes. We will start the paper process.
