Lynne sent a letter from the CHLPC to the City Council and Mayor supporting the effort to preserve the Andrew Kroeger Slaughterhouse. That letter was never delivered and so she will send a copy through Aimee.

Tom Rothwell sent a letter for CHLPC supporting requested uses allowed on Beckmann property in historic area. That usage request was dropped.

DeeAnn volunteered to dust the City Hall glass shelves in the corridor which contain artifacts. Jesse Francis will remove the Faust Park items from Bates House collection. The CHLPC will use the shelves for other Chesterfield artifacts.

NEW BUSINESS

Lynne passed out several oral interviews from the CHLPC archives for each member present to read. Each was asked to write down questions that the interviewer asked or should have asked.

Nancy Greenwood and George said that oral interviews in the CHLPC archives should not just be scanned for the City website but reentered by an intern so they can be searched.

Our former CHLPC members, Arland, Nell and Ted Goedecke, who had been invited to this meeting, were presented with framed certificates of appreciation from the CHLPC which listed their CHLPC volunteer activities.

We enjoyed cookies and drink, contributed by Jane Durrell, as we interviewed each of the former members.

Tom Rothwell will be nominated for CHLPC Chairman at the November 13 meeting.
Other nominations are needed for Vice-Chair, Secretary and Treasurer.
