RE: Minutes - Meeting 3/8/90 Public Works/Parks Committee

A meeting of the Public Works/Parks Committee was held on March 8, 1990. Those in attendance included Councilmember Jade Bute, Chairperson, (Ward II), Councilmember Barry Flachsbart (Ward I), Doug Hartman (Ward III), City Administrator Michael G. Herring, and Director of Public Works/City Engineer William C. Hawn.

1. Chairperson Jade Bute advised the Committee that the Council Liaison for the Recycling Committee has expressed interest in being replaced. The Committee reviewed this matter and agreed to wait until after the April election before re-assigning a liaison for this Committee.
2. City Administrator Michael Herring advised the Committee of the staff recommendation to accept a portion of Forsheer Drive as a public street. The Committee unanimously agreed to forward this recommendation to the entire City Council for action.
3. Director of Public Works William Hawn advised the Committee that work was progressing ahead of schedule on the County Highway construction of the Chesterfield Village Parkway Southeast Quadrant. City Administrator Herring advised the Committee that St. Louis County Highway has awarded a contract to Fred Weber, Incorporated for the construction of the Northeast Quadrant of the Chesterfield Village Parkway (Schoettler Road to Olive Street Road to Conway Road). This work is scheduled to be completed by late 1991.
4. City Administrator Michael Herring advised the Committee the City is very close to obtaining approvals required to rename Chesterfield Village Parkway to Chesterfield Parkway.
5. William Hawn advised the Committee of the negative responses from the Chesterfield Fire District and the State Highway Department regarding the closing of Westernmill Drive at Olive Street Road. The committee agreed not to pursue the closing of Westernmill Drive at Olive Street Road at this time.

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6. The Committee unanimously approved one year extension of escrows for the following developments:
Seasons @ Schoettler - Plat III
Conway Glen - Plat I
7. City Administrator Mike Herring advised the Committee that the Solid Waste Ordinance has been revised to reflect the Committee's comments from the last meeting. The Committee unanimously agreed to forward the proposed ordinance to the entire City Council for action and noted the proposal should be introduced at one meeting and acted upon at a second meeting. A copy of the proposed plan should be forwarded to the Recycling Committee.
8. Michael Herring updated the Committee with respect to the current status of the City's Handicapped Access Program. Mr. Herring noted the work scope has been submitted to Community Development personnel for review and approval.
9. Director William Hawn reviewed the request from Chris Barry to permit the installation of galvanized pipe in the construction of the detention pond discharge structure at the Wellington Estates development. The committee confirmed the decision to require aluminized corrugated metal pipe in such private installations noting that this did not apply to underground detention structures or storm sewer piping.
10. City Administrator Michael Herring reviewed the State Highway Department reply to the City's request for construction of grass medians along Route 340 (Olive Street Road and Clarkson Road). Mr. Herring advised that Director of Planning and Economic Development Jerry Duepner and Director of Public Works/City Engineer William Hawn are to develop proposed median locations and meet with the State Highway Department in an attempt to change the State's current position.
11. Councilmember Bute announced that the next regular meeting of the Public Works Committee will be held on March 22, 1990 at 5:30 P.M.
