RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO PLACE ON THE BALLOT OF AUGUST 2, 1988 THE QUESTION OF COLLECTING A FEES AND CHARGES FOR PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS OF EXPLOSIVES.


WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield has proposed an ordinance to establish fees and charges to be charged by the Department of Planning or its sub-contractors; and

WHEREAS, the question of charging fees needs to be passed upon by the voters of the City of Chesterfield; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD that the following proposition be placed before the voters of the City of Chesterfield at the election to be held on the second day of August, 1988 and that the proposition read as follows:

Shall the fees and charges proposed for enforcement and inspections relating to explosives codes and other public safety codes administered by the City of Chesterfield's Department of Public Works or its subcontractors be approved? The proposed fees and charges are set forth in Bill 117 before the City Council of the City of Chesterfield and relates to permits, inspections and licenses under the explosive ordinance of the City of Chesterfield.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk shall execute, on behalf of the City, all documents required by the Election Board for placing of this proposal before the voters.
