

RESOLUTION 25

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO PLACE ON THE BALLOT OF AUGUST 2, 1988, THE QUESTION OF COLLECTING A FEE FOR LIQUOR LICENSES

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield has proposed an Ordinance to establish fees to be charged for liquor licenses; and


WHEREAS, the question of charging fees needs to be passed upon the voters of the City of Chesterfield; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, AS FOLLOWS:

That the following proposition be placed before the voters of the City of Chesterfield at the election to be held on the second day of August, 1988, and that the proposition read as follows:

Shall the fees and charges proposed for regulation and enforcement of liquor licenses be approved? The proposed fees and charges are set forth in Bill No. 120 before the City Council of Chesterfield and relates to licenses under the Liquor Ordinance of the City of Chesterfield.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk shall execute, on behalf of the City, all documents required by the Election Board for placing of this proposal before the voters.
