

RESOLUTION 26

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO PLACE ON THE BALLOT OF AUGUST 2, 1988, THE QUESTION OF COLLECTING A FEE FOR BUSINESS LICENSES

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield has proposed an Ordinance to establish fees to be charged for business licenses; and

WHEREAS, the question of charging fees needs to be passed upon by the voters of the City of Chesterfield; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, AS FOLLOWS:

That the following proposition be placed before the voters of the City of Chesterfield at the election to be held on the second day of August, 1988, and that the proposition read as follows:

Shall the City of Chesterfield collect business licenses for any commercial activity which is not licensed under any specific Ordinance of the City or exempt by state law in the amount of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) annually?

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk shall execute, on behalf of the City, all documents required by the Election Board for placing of this proposal before the voters.
