

RESOLUTION #46

WHEREAS, St. Louis County has proposed a .5% sales tax for capital improvements which will be submitted to the voters for consideration on February 7, 1989; and,

WHEREAS, the proposal would generate \$500,000,000 over the next ten (10) years to be spent on capital improvement projects county-wide; and,

WHEREAS, \$100,000,000 would be distributed on the basis of population for use by individual municipalities and St. Louis County for stormwater or other capital improvement projects; and,

WHEREAS, over \$310,000,000 is earmarked for road/bridge improvement projects county-wide; and,

WHEREAS, several major projects are improved in or around the City Limits of the City of Chesterfield;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, THAT THE FOLLOWING ACTION BE TAKEN:

1. The City Council for the City of Chesterfield will go on record as officially endorsing this proposed .5% sales tax for capital improvements;
2. Letters will be sent to the appropriate St. Louis County officials informing them of this action taken by City Council;
