

RESOLUTION 62

WHEREAS, questions have arisen regarding the propriety of restricting traffic on public roads in the City of Chesterfield; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has carefully reviewed the implication of closing certain public roads to some citizens of Chesterfield or restricting the use of certain roads to only local residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD AS FOLLOWS:

It is the stated intention of the city council of the City of Chesterfield that it will not adopt traffic control restrictions which would not apply equally to every resident and taxpayer of the City of Chesterfield. Henceforth any restrictions established for a given street should apply to all residents of the City equally.
