

RESOLUTION # 77

WHEREAS, the area known as the City of Chesterfield, as a newly-incorporated municipality, was required to remain a part of the sales tax pool established within St. Louis County; and,

WHEREAS, the area known as the City of Chesterfield produces approximately \$2.5 million more in sales tax receipts than it receives as a member of the sales tax pool; and,


WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council for the City of Chesterfield, on behalf of its residents and business community, desire to become a point-of-sale ("A") city; and,

WHEREAS, other municipalities which are members of the sales tax pool have the opportunity to withdraw from said pool and become point-of-sale ("A") cities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD do hereby resolve to officially petition all appropriate officials within St. Louis County and within the State of Missouri to withdraw from the sales tax pool and become a point-of-sale ("A") city.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administrator be authorized to develop and send all appropriate communications expressing the decision made by the Mayor and City Council with regard to this issue. This action shall be effective retroactively to January 1, 1990.
