

RESOLUTION 84

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO PLACE ON THE BALLOT OF JUNE 5, 1990, THE QUESTION OF COLLECTING FEES FOR THE CARRYING ON OF BUSINESSES IN THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield has proposed an Ordinance to establish fees to be charged to the businesses conducted within the City of Chesterfield based upon square footage and the classification of use for each business; and

WHEREAS, the question of charging fees needs to be passed upon by the voters of the City of Chesterfield pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Missouri; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Chesterfield, St. Louis County, Missouri as follows:

That the following proposition be placed before the voters of the City of Chesterfield for the election to be held on the 5th day of June, 1990, that the proposition be read as follows:


To charge a fee to businesses within the City of Chesterfield, as authorized in RSMo 94.110, is as follows:

1. Manufacturing/Warehousing \$.02 per sq. ft.
2. Service/Office \$.04 per sq. ft.
3. Retail \$.08 per sq. ft.

The maximum license fee to be charged would be \$10,000.00 per year per business location. The minimum license fee to be charged would be \$25.00 per year per business location.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk of the City of Chesterfield so execute on behalf of the City all documents required by the Election Board for the placing of this proposal before the voters.
