

RESOLUTION # 117

WHEREAS, The City of Chesterfield, through its Mayor and City Council are concerned with the safety of the residents and their children.

WHEREAS, the intersection of Appalachian Trail and Hidden Oak is in close proximity to the Shenandoah Valley Elementary School.

WHEREAS, Shenandoah Valley Elementary School consists of approximately Eight Hundred (800) children, ages five through thirteen, who attend said school on any given school day.

WHEREAS, Two Hundred (200) of said children either walk or car pool to said school on any given school day which necessitates the crossing of said intersection.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that after due consideration and deliberation and review of the police records, the Mayor and City Council may authorize the installation of stop signs as warranted at the intersection of Appalachian Trail and Hidden Oak.
