

RESOLUTION NO. 146

WHEREAS, it has been determined that under the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Chesterfield, basketball nets which are attached to a pole and which pole exceeds six (6) feet in height are not permitted; and

WHEREAS, if the basketball pole exceeds six (6) feet in height, then it is considered a structure and therefore must comply with all front, side and rear setback requirements of the Zoning Ordinance; and


WHEREAS, the City Council, after having reviewed the issues involved and having determined that basketball poles with backboards are sufficiently elevated to minimize or eliminate totally any sight problems, has determined that it is its intention to institute a request to the Planning Commission to amend the Zoning Ordinance so as to allow for basketball poles and backboards to be exempt from the setback requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield is currently undergoing the process to amend the Zoning Ordinances of the City of Chesterfield and the City Council hereby declares its intention not to enforce this requirement;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

That the City Administrator is directed to prepare and submit to the Planning Commission for consideration in the development of the new Zoning Ordinance being prepared and considered by the City and ordinance which would exempt basketball poles and backboards from setback requirements.
