

RESOLUTION #150

A RESOLUTION URGING THE DIRECTORS OF THE CHESTERFIELD FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TO RECONSIDER THEIR DECISION TO TERMINATE THE FIRE DISTRICT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE CENTRAL COUNTY EMERGENCY DISPATCHING SERVICE

WHEREAS, in order to provide for efficient, cost effective and professional fire and emergency dispatching services to the West St. Louis County area, a central dispatching entity was formed in 1973; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield deemed it advantageous to the inhabitants of Chesterfield and to the property located therein, joined with other West St. Louis County public entities, including Chesterfield Fire Protection District, in the establishment of the emergency dispatching service now known as "Central County Emergency Dispatching Service"; and,


WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Chesterfield Fire Protection District has announced its intention to terminate participation in the Central County Emergency Dispatching Service, effective January 1, 1994; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Chesterfield feels that the decision of the Chesterfield Fire Protection District Board of Directors to withdraw from the Central County Emergency Dispatching Service has the potential to affect adversely the inhabitants and property located in all the entities participating in the Central County Emergency Dispatching Service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Chesterfield, Missouri, strongly urge the Directors of the Chesterfield Fire Protection District to reconsider their decision to terminate participation in the Central County Alarm Service.


