
WHEREAS, notification to property owners by utilities providers of work to be conducted in utility easements on private property is desired by the City of Chesterfield to provide for the goodwill, safety, and aesthetic concerns of residents and property owners; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the inconvenience and concerns on behalf of property owners that may result from the work conducted by utility providers should notification to property owners not occur; and

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield has requested of utility providers that they establish policies regarding notification of work to be performed in their easements in advance of such work when feasible;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Chesterfield, Missouri, does hereby support, encourage and promote prior notification by all utility providers to property owners of work conducted on utility easements.
