

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD TO APPLY FOR A MUNICIPAL PARKS GRANT FOR THE PROCUREMENT AND INSTALLATION OF 11,880 FEET OF LINEAR TRAIL, PARK ENTRANCE SIGN, GAZEBO, AND A FISHING DOCK ON THE LAKE AT THE NEW RIVERS EDGE PARK.**

Whereas, the City of Chesterfield is a growing and vibrant community in St. Louis County, and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Chesterfield deems it desirable and necessary to improve its parks to serve its citizens as well as the general public; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS;

An application will be made to the Municipal Parks Grant Program in the County of St. Louis for a Grant-In- Aid to reimburse the City for a portion of the cost to construct the trails, gazebo and fishing dock at the new Rivers Edge Park, by the Municipal Parks Commission upon the City's completion of the project.

Chesterfield Staff will prepare and submit the project proposal to construct the trails, gazebo and fishing dock at Rivers Edge Park to the Municipal Parks Grant Commission.

The City of Chesterfield hereby authorizes the City Administrator to sign and execute the necessary documents for submitting the project proposal application for a Grant-In-Aid under the Municipal Parks Grant Commission.

If a grant is awarded, the City of Chesterfield will enter into agreement or contract with the Commission regarding said grant.

This Resolution Passed Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage approval.

**RESOLUTION NO. 402 - AUTHORIZES APPLICATION FOR MUNICIPAL PARKS GRANT**

As detailed in the enclosed MEMO, prepared by Tom McCarthy, Parks/Recreation Director, Staff is seeking authorization to apply for a grant of \$275,000, from the Municipal Parks Grant Commission. These grant funds, if approved, will cover the construction/installation of "over two miles of surface stone trails, throughout the **Rivers Edge Park**", which is located north of I-64, north of the Monarch/Chesterfield Levee Trail and north of the Taubman Prestige Outlet Mall. In addition to the construction of the trails noted above, the application will also seek funding for signage, a gazebo and fishing dock, with a minimal "matching" requirement, from the City of Chesterfield, of just under \$25,500. Approval of the enclosed RESOLUTION will officially authorized Staff to submit an application for these funds.

Please note that, when the Taubman Prestige Outlet Mall development was approved, an agreement was secured from Taubman to allow parking for access to the levee trail and the Rivers Edge Park, on the western-most end of their property. Additionally, the land upon which this park and proposed trails is located is part of a 188-acre parcel, donated to the City by the Monarch-Chesterfield Levee District. The lake, itself, is 17.5 acres in size.

Mike, we are in the process of finalizing the Municipal Parks Grant for this year and there are two items we need. The first item is a City Resolution of Support from City Council for the project that we are requesting the grant dollars for and would include the Mayor's signature. The second item we need is the attached Certification Page with Mr. Herring's signature on it.

In brief, we are putting the grant together to install just over two miles of surface stone trails throughout the Rivers Edge Park along with a park entrance sign, a gazebo, and fishing dock adjacent to the lake. I have also included a map of the park with the trail marked in red. The gazebo and dock would be at the western end of the lake.

Budgetary numbers for the components of the Grant:


