

RESOLUTION #134

WHEREAS, It has been determined that the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Chesterfield, and specifically the sign regulations therein, prohibits the use of a an awning containing a logo or name of the business in conjunction with other signage on property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, after having reviewed the same wishes to declare its intention to institute a request to the Planning Commission to amend the Zoning Ordinance so as to allow for an awning to contain a logo or name of the business in conjunction with other business signs; and

WHEREAS, awnings are to be considered Architectural decoration; and

WHEREAS, the use of a logo and business name on an awning is to be considered an aesthetic improvement and decorative in nature.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, the City Administrator is directed to prepare and submit to the Planning Commission a request to amend the sign regulations to provide for awnings containing a logo or name of the business in addition to other signage in appropriate zoning districts.
