## RESOLUTION #143

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield has received inquiries with regard to the City receiving bequests, gifts and donations for flood relief; and

WHEREAS, the state statutes of the State of Missouri allow for the City to be able to receive bequests, gifts and donations of all kinds of property; and

WHEREAS, the City, having received some funds to date, believes that it is in the City's best interest to set up a fund to identify these donations as being separate from the general revenues of the City of Chesterfield and that said funds be designated for flood relief.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Chesterfield hereby directs the Director of Finance to establish, through appropriate accounting procedures, a flood relief fund which is to be separate from the general revenues of the City of Chesterfield. Said funds to be expended by resolution of the City Council of the City of Chesterfield for funds which have not been donated with specific directions as to use. Any funds which have been donated for specific use and which use is related to the flood relief are to be made in accordance with the directions of the donor.
