

RESOLUTION NO. 242

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD WITHDRAWING
FROM THE HIGHWAY 109 CORRIDOR COMMISSION

WHEREAS, for the benefit of motor vehicle traffic relief in West County, the City of Chesterfield has participated in the Highway 109 study; and

WHEREAS, the Highway 109 Corridor Commission's scope has been reduced to a safety issue study, focusing solely on Highway 109; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is confident that the Highway 109 Corridor Commission can determine the necessary safety-related improvements without the participation of Chesterfield representatives; and


WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield remains interested in participating in a regional study to determine solutions to motor vehicle traffic problems throughout West County and in particular concerning Clarkson Road, Clayton Road, Wildhorse Creek Road, Highway 109, Highway 141, Olive Boulevard, Baxter Road and Highway 40/I-64; and

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield encourages surrounding municipalities to keep an open mind to all solutions for motor vehicle traffic relief in our area until such a study can be completed, otherwise uninformed decisions would result which could be unrepresentative of their respective constituencies.


