

RESOLUTION 27

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO PLACE ON THE BALLOT OF AUGUST 2, 1988 THE QUESTION OF COLLECTING A FEE FOR COURT COSTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield has proposed an ordinance to establish fees to be charged for court costs; and

WHEREAS, the question of charging fees needs to be passed upon by the voters of the City of Chesterfield; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD that the following proposition be placed before the voters of the City of Chesterfield at the election to be held on the second day of August, 1988 and that the proposition read as follows:

Shall the City of Chesterfield collect Court Costs in the amount of Twelve Dollars (\$12.00). A fee of Two Dollars (\$2.00) may be assessed as costs in each court proceeding filed in the Municipal Court for police training costs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk shall execute, on behalf of the City, all documents required by the Election Board for placing of this proposal before the voters.
