

RESOLUTION #86

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD TO PLACE ON THE BALLOT OF JUNE 5, 1990, THE QUESTION OF COLLECTING A FEE FOR RESPONDING TO A FALSE ALARM BY THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield has passed Ordinance # 436, which establishes a fee to be charged by the police department when they respond to false alarms; and,

WHEREAS, the question of charging fees needs to be passed upon by the voter of the City of Chesterfield; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Chesterfield, St. Louis County, Missouri, that the following proposition be placed before the voters of the City of Chesterfield at the election to be held on June 5, 1990, and the proposition shall read as follows:

Shall fees be charged for all false alarms responded to by the Police Department of the City of Chesterfield, which correspond to the following schedule:

1st offense:	\$25.00
2nd offense:	\$50.00
Each subsequent offenses per calendar year:	\$50.00

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk of the City of Chesterfield shall execute on behalf of the City all documents required by the Election Board for the placing of this proposal before the voters.
