

RESOLUTION #93

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD CALLING UPON THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO TAKE IMMEDIATE ACTION TO CLEAN UP THE DIOXIN SITES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD.

WHEREAS, two (2) sites have been identified within the city limits of the City of Chesterfield, namely the Hellwig property and the Baxter Gardens properties which have dioxin contaminated soil on site; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Government, through the Superfund Law, is responsible for the clean up of this property and to properly contain and dispose of the hazardous substances found thereon; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency office located in Kansas City, Missouri has notified the City of their intention to dig up the contaminated soil from the Hellwig property and the Baxter Gardens property and that the Hellwig property shall have the contaminated soil placed in plastic bags and stored in a metal building to be erected on the property to contain the soil until such time as it is disposed of; and

WHEREAS, both the Hellwig property and the Baxter Gardens property are located in highly visible areas of the City of Chesterfield and are of great concern to the City and to the land owners.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

That the City of Chesterfield calls upon the Environmental Protection Agency to immediately take all steps necessary to dig up and store the contaminated soil in such a fashion as to protect the interests of the City of Chesterfield and the residents who live there.
